

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

BACKSEAT PROMOTIONS, its producers, and staff are interested that you enjoy the event. Your consideration of the guidelines and others will help in making this a successful event. We thank you for your participation.

EXHIBITOR HOURS:

The exhibitor entrance will open one hour prior to show time to allow for cleaning and arranging of displays etc.

Show hours: Sat. 10 am to 8 pm. Sun. 10 am to 6 pm.

MOVE-IN:

FRIDAY, NOON TO 10 PM. All set up MUST be complete by 10:00 pm, as there cannot be any set up or move-in on Saturday during show hours.

MOVE-OUT:

SUNDAY, AFTER 6 PM TO 9 PM. Tear down is not permitted until awards ceremony completed. Doors will not be open for the removal of vehicles until all rented stanchions are returned to the office. All removal must be completed on time, or you may be responsible for towing, removal, storage, or clean up charges - unless otherwise agreed with show management in writing.

ADMISSION PASSES:

****TWO WEEKEND PASSES with each paid and accepted entry will be supplied at move-in. Additional passes are available during move-in at a reduced cost. You will be required to present your pass for entrance into the show**

AWARDS: Each entry will be classified at move in, and judged by independent judges. Awards ceremony: 4:00pm Sunday .

HOW TO DISPLAY YOUR VEHICLE

Your vehicle is judged in five areas, Body and paint, interior, engine, undercarriage, its overall detail and cleanliness. Each of these areas are evaluated on the quality, difficulty and extent of the change or modifications made to the vehicle.

Judges can only evaluate what can be seen. If you want the engine, trunk and interior judge, leave your vehicle open as you wish it to be judged, from the show opening to the awards. If your vehicle has modifications which are not readily visible, document them in a handbook placed in a visible location in the vehicle. This will ensure that the judges become aware of all modifications.

Displays are an important part of showing your entry. A good display only enhances your vehicle. Your display should have stanchions, rope or an enclosure that will protect your vehicle. Flooring such as carpet helps in setting off your vehicle from others.

If you have lights or neon signs incorporated in your display. Please request a electrical form from NES Electrical by calling 604-469-2726.

We award cash prizes for first, second and third in both Club and Individual displays.

HOW TO ENTER YOUR VEHICLE INTO THE SHOW:

Please complete this form and send it along with a good quality photograph. Please have your \$25.00 per vehicle entry fee accompany this entry application. Show Management reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry at its own discretion.

1. **NO ALARMS** of any kind are to be set while the vehicle is in the building.
2. For promotional purposes the producers have the right to use any photographs of registered displayed vehicles or submitted photographs of vehicles.
3. **No COMMERCIAL advertising**, or distribution of hand-outs, business cards flyers etc. will be allowed with any non commercial display. A display vehicle specification display sign showing who made modifications is allowable.
4. Once the exhibitor has placed the vehicle and its display, they shall not be able to be removed or concealed by the exhibitors until the declaration by the show management that move-out has officially begun.
5. The vehicle must be removed from the building by the conclusion of the designated move-out time or the exhibitor will be responsible for any towing and/or storage fees. Anything different must be in writing by the producers of this show and must be approved by building management.
6. All displays must be free standing and composed of fireproof materials. ALL BATTERIES MUST BE DISCONNECTED AND GAS CAPS EITHER LOCKED OR TAPED. Drip pans must be used under your engine, transmission and rear end.
7. The owner of the displayed vehicle must have his/her own insurance for the vehicle, the display and any accessories. The insurance must include public liability and the required permits for driving in and out of the show building.
8. Club displays are encouraged. You are also encouraged to promote your club events and functions, as well as memberships.
9. The show management has the right to have an exhibitor or a member of his/her party removed from the show and building for misconduct or mischievous behaviour.
10. Sending in an application, will be taken as the understanding that these regulations and all conditions are agreed to by the entrant.
